IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Providing for a Consumer Member on all Regulatory Boards and Commissions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 2, § 8, additional. Title 2 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 8 to read as follows:

§ 8. Regulatory boards and commissions

Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Governor shall appoint a person, representing the consumer, to every state regulatory board, agency or commission.
