STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Sale Price of Liquor.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 28, § 451, amended. The last sentence of the first paragraph of section 451 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 2 of chapter 268 of the public laws of 1971, is amended to read as follows:

Notwithstanding the other provisions of this section, the commission, with the approval of the Commissioner of Finance and Administration, may reduce the price of liquor in one store 2 stores, one of which shall be the state liquor store in Sanford and establish at that store those stores the price to which the 10% discount in section 204 shall be applicable.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to permit the State Liquor Commission to reduce prices in 2 state liquor stores, instead of one, and the 2nd store will be in Sanford.
