STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Providing for Group Insurance for National Guardsmen Called up to State Active Duty.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 37-A, § 214, amended. Section 214 of Title 37-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 580 of the public laws of 1971, is amended by adding a new paragraph at the end to read as follows:

The Adjutant General may enter into insuring agreements with authorized insurance companies for group life insurance on behalf of each participating national guardsman called to state active duty and to pay from departmental funds the cost of each individual's premium for such insurance. Any such insurance agreement entered into under this authority shall be approved by the Insurance Commissioner before it shall become effective.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to provide life insurance for national guardsmen only during such periods as they may be called to exclusively perform state active duty as differentiated from duty performed in their federal status.
