STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Elevator Mechanics.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 26, § 439, amended. The 2nd sentence of the first paragraph of section 439 of Title 26 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 312 of the public laws of 1967, is repealed as follows:

Elevator work in industrial plants, manufacturing plants and hospitals may be performed by plant personnel who are not licensed under sections 439 to 441, provided such work is supervised by the plant engineer.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to provide that all elevator work shall be performed by a licensed elevator mechanic.
