**AN ACT Repealing the Statute Authorizing a Civil Action for
Alienation of Affections.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 19, § 167, repealed. Section 167 of Title 19 of the Revised Statutes is repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill repeals the statute allowing a person to bring suit for damages against a person alienating the affections of a spouse.
