STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Increasing Registration Fees for Trucks.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 29, § 242, sub-§ 1, ¶ A, amended. The first sentence of paragraph A of subsection I of section 242 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

Used for the conveyance of passengers, \$15 \$20.

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 29, § 244, amended. The first sentence of the 2nd paragraph of section 244 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

The minimum fee shall never be less than \$2 \$3.

Sec. 3. R. S., T. 29, § 244, amended. The last sentence of the 4th paragraph of section 244 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

All boat trailers registered for a gross weight in excess of 2,000 pounds but not more than 4,000 pounds shall pay a registration fee of \$5 \$7.

Sec. 4. R. S., T. 29, § 244, amended. The 5th paragraph of section 244 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 9 of chapter 245 of the public laws of 1967, is amended to read as follows:

Camp trailers, registered in excess of 2,000 lbs. gross weight, shall be assessed a registration fee of \$5 \$7.

Sec. 5. R. S., T. 29, § 244, amended. The 6th paragraph of section 244 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 2 of chapter 18 of the public laws of 1965, is further amended to read as follows:

House trailers shall be registered and pay a fee of \$5 \$7 for such registration.

Sec. 6. R. S., T. 29, § 245, amended. Section 245 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

§ 245. —semitrailers

The annual fees for the registration of semitrailers shall be in accordance with this section and shall accompany the application for registration.

Sec. 7. R. S., T. 29, § 245-A, amended. The 4th sentence of the first paragraph of section 245-A of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 448 of the public laws of 1967, and as amended by chapter 133 of the public laws of 1971, is further amended to read as follows:

The fee for such plate shall be \$5 \$7 for each registration year, or portion thereof, for the number of years of valid use from the year of issue to the end of the semipermanent plate program; and there shall be no refund of payment of such fee.

Sec. 8. R. S., T. 29, § 245-A, amended. The 2nd paragraph of section 245-A of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 448 of the public laws of 1967, is amended to read as follows:

Provisions of this section shall not prohibit the succeeding Legislatures from increasing the base fee of \$5 \$7 per year, or portion thereof; and registrants shall make additional payment to the State, under any new rate enacted, for the remaining period of plates originally issued, to the end of the semipermanent plate program.

Sec. 9. R. S., T. 29, § 246, amended. The first paragraph of section 246 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

With each application for registration of a motor truck shall be paid an annual registration fee graduated as follows when equipped with pneumatic tires:
