STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Compensation under Workmen's Compensation Act.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 39, § 62, amended. Section 62 of Title 39 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

§ 62. Compensation unaffected by savings or insurance

No savings or insurance of the injured employee independent of this Act or derived from a collective bargaining agreement shall be taken into consideration in determining the compensation to be paid, nor shall benefits derived from any source other than the employer be considered in fixing the compensation due.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to provide that benefits derived from a collective bargaining agreement shall not be considered in awarding compensation under the Workmen's Compensation Act.
