STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Reports of Bureau of Labor and Industry.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 26, § 48, additional. Title 26 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 48 to read as follows:

§ 48. Reports

All reports to the Bureau of Labor and Industry involving deaths, injuries and occupational diseases shall be available to the injured employee, his survivors or representatives upon payment of reasonable cost for the copies.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to make available the reports to the Bureau of Labor and Industry to the injured employee or his representatives.
