AN ACT Relating to Discovery Procedures in Workmen's Compensation Hearings.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 39, § 93, sub-§ 3, amended. The first paragraph of subsection 3 of section 93 of Title 39 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by chapter 386 of the public laws of 1969, is amended by adding at the end the following new sentence:

This paragraph shall apply to the investigation and determination of the existence of 3rd party liability.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of the bill is to provide that discovery procedure in workmen's compensation hearings will apply to determination of 3rd party liability.
