COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1160, L. D. 1493, Bill, "AN ACT
Establishing a State Register of Natural Areas."

Amend said Bill in that part designated "§3313." by striking
out in the 7th line (6th line in L. D.) the following "12 members,
9 of whom" and inserting in place thereof the following '13 members,
10 of whom'

Further amend said Bill by striking out in the first line of
subsection 1 of that part designated "§3313." (same in L. D.) the
underlined figure "9" and inserting in place thereof the underlined
figure '10' and by inserting after the underlined words and punctuation
"Sea and Shore Fisheries," in the 7th line (6th line in L. D.)
the following 'the Forestry Department,'

Further amend said Bill by striking out in the 4th line (same
in L. D.) of subsection 4 of that part designated "§3314." the underlined
figure "45" and inserting in place thereof the underlined figure
'60'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to include the Forestry
Department, which includes the Maine Geological Survey, in the
Natural Areas Advisory Board and to change the time for appraisal
of an area or site which the State may wish to acquire from 45 days
to 60 days.
