COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 462, L.D. 1497, Bill,
"AN ACT to Amend the Personal Property and Homestead Exemption
Laws to Provide for Realistic and Liberalized Exemptions."

Amend said Bill in section 1 by striking out in the last
and next to the last lines (next to the last line in L.D.) the
underlined punctuation and words: ", guns not exceeding \$150 in
value"
