COMMITTEE AMENDMENT" A" to H.P. 1178, L.D. 1517, Bi 1, "An ACT to Create a Commission to Name Public Buildings, Bridges, Highways and Other Public Works."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the 2nd underlined paragraph of that part of section 1 designated "§ 266." and inserting in place thereof the following:

'The Memorial Name Commission shall consist of 9 members, 5 of whom shall serve only during that period of time when they occupy the positions entitling them to membership as follows:

State Historian; the Chancellor of the University of Maine; the Commissioner of Parks and Recreation; the Commissioner of Transportation; and the Chairman of the Maine Historic Preservation

Commission. Two of the members shall be appointed by the Governor from among the citizens of Maine to serve at his pleasure. One member shall be appointed by the President of the Senate to serve at his pleasure and one member shall be appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives to serve at his pleasure. In the event the Governor, President of the Senate or Speaker of the House does not succeed himself in office, the previously appointed members of the Memorial Name Commission may continue in office until such time as their successors are appointed.

Statement of Fact

This amendment provides for the appointment of public members at large to the commission. It also adds the commissioner of Parks and Recreation and the Commissioner of Transportation to the commission.
