SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 465, L. D. 1521, Bill, "AN ACT to Create a Department of Conservation."

Amend said Bill in that part designated "§5013." of section 16 by inserting after the underlined words "composed of the" in the 2nd line (same in L. D.) the following:

'Land Use Regulation Commission and the'


Further amend said Bill in that part designated "§5013." of section 16 by inserting after the first paragraph the following:

'1. Land Use Regulation Commission. The Maine Land Use Regulation Commission as established by Title 12, chapter 206-A.'

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "§5013." of section 16 by renumbering subsections 1 to 4 to be subsections 2 to 5.
