STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Dogs on Leash and Providing Special License for Hunting Dogs.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 7, § 3600, additional. Title 7 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 3600, to read as follows:

§ 3600. Dogs on leash; exceptions

All dogs shall be safely on leash at all times, except: When kept indoors or confined in any building or closed structure; whenever kept under section 3552; hunting dogs, specially licensed as provided in this section while being trained or actually hunting under human control and supervision.

Hunting dogs shall be specially licensed and a fee of \$1 shall be paid to the city or town clerk, in addition to the fees provided for in section 3451, who shall issue a red-numbered tag which shall be attached to the dog's collar and worn at all times. All dogs not so licensed, on leash or red-tagged as provided are declared to be a public nuisance.

Violations of any of the provisions of this section shall be punishable by a fine of not less than \$50 nor more than \$200 to be recoverd by complaint before any District Court.

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 7, §§ 3601, 3602 and 3605, repealed. Sections 3601, 3602 and 3605 of Title 7 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, are repealed.
