STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Nonresident Big Game Hunting in Maine.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 12, § 2401, sub-§ 3, ¶ F, amended. Paragraph F of subsection 3 of section 2401 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 1 of chapter 409 of the public laws of 1971, is amended to read as follows:

F. Nonresident big game hunting Permits hunting for all species including bear and deer.

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 12, § 2401-B, sub-§ 16, ¶ I, additional. Subsection 16 of section 2401-B of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 2 of chapter 409 of the public laws of 1971, is amended by adding a new paragraph I to read as follows:

I. Nonresident big game licenses. The commissioner is authorized to issue no more than 35,000 nonresident big game licenses and shall establish procedure for issuing on a first come first serve basis.

Sec. 3. Effective date. This Act shall become effective January 1, 1974.

STATEMENT OF FACT

It is the intent of this bill to establish a realistic fee for nonresident big game hunting in Maine and to establish a limit on the number of licenses issued to nonresidents.
