AN ACT Prohibiting Service Charges on Sales Tax Through Credit Card Sales.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 17, § 802, additional. Title 17 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 802 to read as follows:

§ 802. Sales tax on credit card sales

It shall be illegal to include the sales tax in determining any discount or service fee charges on a credit card sale.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to prohibit any charges based on the sales tax portion of a credit card sale.
