COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to H.P. 1196, L.D. 1530, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to Agreements under Minimum Wage Law."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the amending
clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'3-A. Notice of exemption. Any employer of an employee exempt
under subsection 3, paragraphs B, E, F or K must provide such employee
with a written notice of employment which clearly states that the
minimum wage and overtime provisions of this subchapter do not apply
and sets forth the wage rate proposed to be paid. This requirement
shall apply only in situations where the period of employment
extends beyond one normal work week.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide that certain persons
exempt from the minimum wage must be given notice in writing in
order to be exempt or work for less than the minimum wage.
