wastewater to be treated and other physical conditions affecting such treatment plants and shall specify the qualifications the operator in responsible charge must have to supervise successfully the operation of said facilities so as to protect the public health or prevent nuisance conditions or unlawful pollution.

Sec. 4. R. S., T. 32, § 4177-A, additional. Title 32 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 4177-A to read as follows:

§ 4177-A. Special certification

Persons affected by this legislation who are operators of wastewater treatment plants who have, on the effective date of this Act, served for at least 6 of the last 12 months in the capacity of operators of wastewater treatment plants not previously covered by section 4172 shall be issued special certification, which shall be renewable but shall be limited to operators who qualify under this section and only be effective in connection with operations at the wastewater treatment plant where the operator was employed at the time of the original certification. A certificate so issued will be valid only for that particular classification level of wastewater treatment plants.
