HOUSE AMENDMENT " B " to S. P. 493, L. D. 1535, Bill,
"AN ACT to Revise the Election Laws."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 28 the following:

'Sec. 29. R. S., T. 21, § 631, repealed and replaced.

Section 631 of Title 21 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by sections 8 and 9 of chapter 225 of the public laws of 1967, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

§ 631. Time or schedule; regular elections

The registrar shall accept registrations during the hours of 10 a.m. to 12 noon, 2 p. m. to 5 p. m. and 7 p. m. to 9 p.m. on the 6th to 12th business days next prior to a regular election. He shall accept registrations on election day, but not on the 5 business days next prior to it.'

Further amend said Bill by renumbering sections 29 to 58 to be sections 30 to 59.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to set up uniform hours for registration and to allow persons to register on election day.
