HOUSE AMENDMENT "D" to S. P. 493, L. D. 1535, Bill, "AN ACT to Revise the Election Laws."

Amend said Bill in section 12 by striking out in the 12th line (same in L. D.) the underlined figure, punctuation and word "3. Loses." and inserting in place thereof the following: '3. Residence retained.'

Further amend said Bill by inserting after section 28 the following:

- 'Sec. 28-A. R. S., T. 21, §631, sub-§§2 5, amended.

 Subsections 2 to 5 of section 631 of Title 21 of the Revised

 Statutes, as amended, are further amended to read as follows:
- 2. Municipality of 2,501 to 5,000. In a municipality of 2,501 to 5,000 population, he shall accept registrations from 1 to 5 p. m. and from 7 to 9 p. m. on the 4th to 6th business days next prior to election day. He shall net accept registrations in person on election day er but not on the 3 business days next prior to it.
- 3. Municipality of 5,001 to 10,000. In a municipality of 5,001 to 10,000 population, he shall accept registrations from 1 to 5 p. m. and from 7 to 9 p. m. on the 6th to 10th business days next prior to election day. He shall not accept registrations in person on election day ex but not on the 5 business days next prior to it.

- 4. Municipality of 10,001 to 24,000 population. municipality of 10,001 to 24,000 population, he shall accept registrations from 1 to 5 p. m. and from 7 to 9 p. m. on the 8th to 14th business days next prior to election day. He shall not accept registrations in person on election day or but not on the 7 business days next prior to it.
- 5. Municipality of 24,001 or more. In a municipality of 24,001 or more population, he shall accept registrations from 1 to 5 p. m. and from 7 to 9 p. m. on the 10th to 18th business days next prior to election day. He shall not accept registrations in person on election day or but not on the 9 business days next prior to it.'

Statement of Fact

It is the intent of this amendment to permit registrations in person on election day but not a certain number of days prior to it.
