HOUSE AMENDMENT " F " to S. P. 493, L. D. 1535, Bill,
"AN ACT to Revise the Election Laws."

Amend said Bill in section 11 in that part designated
"§ 241." by striking out in the last 2 lines of subsection 3
(same in L.D.) the underlined words "for at least 30 days next
prior to election day"
