HOUSE AMENDMENT "G" to S.P. 493, L.D. 1535, Bill, "AN ACT
to Revise the Election Laws."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 28 the following:

'Sec. 28-A. R. S., T. 21, § 631, sub-§§2 - 5, repealed and
replaced. Subsection 2 to 5 of section 631 of Title 21 of the
Revised Statutes, as amended, are repealed and the following enacted
in place thereof:

2. Municipality of 2,501 to 5,000. In a municipality of 2,501
to 5,000 population, he shall accept registrations from 1 to 5 p. m.
and from 7 to 9 p. m. on the 3rd to 6th business days next prior to
election day. He shall accept registrations on election day, but not
on the 2 business days next prior to it.

3. Municipality of 5,001 to 10,000. In a municipality of
5,001 to 10,000 population, he shall accept registrations from 1 to
5 p. m. and from 7 to 9 p. m. on the 4th to 10th business days next
prior to election day. He shall accept registrations on election day,
but not on the 3 business days next prior to it.

4. Municipality of 10,001 to 25,000 population. In a
municipality of 10,001 to 25,000 population, he shall accept registrations
from 1 to 5 p. m. and from 7 to 9 p. m. on the 5th to 14th business
days next prior to election day. He shall accept registrations on
election day, but not on the 4 business days next prior to it.

5. Municipality of 25,001 to 50,000. In a municipality of 25,001 to 50,000 population, he shall accept registrations from 1 to 5 p. m. and from 7 to 9 p. m. on the 6th to 18th business days next prior to election day. He shall accept registrations on election day, but not on the 5 business days next prior to it.

6. Municipality of 50,001 or more. In a municipality of 50,001 or more population, he shall accept registrations from 1 to 5 p. m. and from 7 to 9 p. m. on the 7th to 18th business days next prior to election day. He shall accept registrations on election day, but not on the 6 business days next prior to it.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to clarify the law relating to time for accepting voters for registration.
