HOUSE AMENDMENT "P" to S. P. 493, L. D. 1535, Bill, "AN ACT
to Revise the Election Laws."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of section 27.

Further amend said Bill by inserting after section 42 the
following:

'Sec. 42-A. R. S., T. 21, §1031, sub-§4, additional. Section
1031 of Title 21 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new
subsection 4 to read as follows:

4. Provided by municipality. The municipal officers of each
municipality shall provide at least one voting machine for each 450
voters qualified to vote at each voting place.

Sec. 42-B. Effective date. Section 42-A of this Act shall
become effective January 1, 1974.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide a minimum limit
on voting machines. Currently there is no minimum limit on
voting machines.
