COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 481, L. D. 1548, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to Time of Holding a Municipal Caucus Prior to a State
Convention."

Amend said Bill by striking out in the last 2 lines, before
the Statement of Fact, the following underlined words "only on the
2nd Tuesday of March" and inserting in place thereof the following
'prior to April 1st'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to set a deadline for a
municipal caucus throughout the State prior to a state convention,
in order to create more interest on the part of the people.
