STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Time of Holding a Municipal Caucus Prior to a State Convention.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 21, § 361, sub-§ 1-A, additional. Section 361 of Title 21 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new subsection 1-A, to read as follows:

1-A. Time. A municipal caucus, held biennially during general election year for the purpose of electing delegates to a state convention and for any other business that may come before a state convention, shall be held only on the 2nd Tuesday of March.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to set a uniform date for a municipal caucus throughout the State prior to a state convention, in order to create more interest on the part of the people.
