COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 1210, L.D. 1562, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to Possession of Marijuana for Personal Use."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end, before the Statement of
Fact, a new sentence to read as follows:

'Provided, however, that possession of more than 3 ounces of
Cannabis or marijuana shall create a rebuttable presumption
against personal use.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide a rebuttable
presumption against personal use when there is possession of more
than 3 ounces of Cannabis or marijuana.
