HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 1212, L. D. 1574, Bill, "AN ACT  
to Amend the Employment Security Law."

Amend said Bill in subsection 3 of section 13 by  
inserting after the word "unable" in the 6th line (5th in L. D.)  
the following 'in the exercise of due diligence at reasonable  
times and by reasonable means'; and by inserting after the word  
"address" in the 7th line (6th line in L. D.) the following  
'and such inability is confirmed by nonconclusive affidavit of his  
employer or his agent filed with the Employment Security Commission'
