STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Providing for Suspension of Motor Vehicle Operator's License of Person Convicted of Possession of Marijuana in a Motor Vehicle.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 29, c. 11, sub-c. V-A, additional. Chapter 11 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new subchapter V-A to read as follows:

SUBCHAPTER V-A POSSESSION OF MARIJUANA

§ 1321. Possession of marijuana

The license or permit and privilege to operate a motor vehicle of any person convicted for the possession of Cannabis (marijuana) in a motor vehicle shall be immediately suspended for 4 months by the Secretary of State upon receipt of an attested copy of the court record of such conviction.
