STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Penalty for Use of Drugs on Animals at Agricultural Fairs.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 7, § 74, amended. The first sentence of the 3rd paragraph of section 74 of Title 7 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

The Commissioner of Agriculture commissioner may, in addition to or instead of any criminal prosecution under this section, bar any owner, trainer or other person resonsible for any animal showing a positive test from participating in any pulling contest for a period of 2 years one year.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to reduce the ban on competition for violation of this section from 2 years to one year.
