COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1256, L. D. 1581, Bill,  
"AN ACT to Provide Schooling for Juvenile Offenders in Place  
of Incarceration."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the  
enacting clause and before the Statement of Fact and inserting  
in place thereof the following:

'Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General  
Fund the sum of \$50,000 to the Department of Mental Health and  
Corrections, Bureau of Corrections, Division of Probation and  
Parole for the purpose of paying the costs of education and  
related expenses, including residential schools, for juveniles  
so designated by the courts, as a diversionary tool for juveniles  
in need of supervision who would not necessarily need to be  
incarcerated in a state training center. The breakdown shall  
be as follows:
