STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Net Asset Limitation Under the Elderly Householders Tax Relief Act.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 36, § 6109, amended. Section 6109 of Title 36 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 503 of the public laws of 1971, is amended to read as follows:

§ 6109. Net asset limitation

A claimant may not have net assets, consisting of real estate, bank accounts, cash and securities in the net value of more than \$30,000 \$45,000.

FISCAL NOTE

It is estimated that the cost of this bill will approximate \$45,000 per year.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this change is to attempt to take into account and exclude from the asset limitation an amount approximating the value of a typical home for those presently living in their own home and at the same time to give this same added assistance to renters.
