AN ACT Relating to Grounds for Judicial Separation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 19, § 582-A, additional. Title 19 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 582-A to read as follows:

§ 582-A. Grounds

In addition to the grounds specified in this chapter, the grounds for divorce as enumerated in section 691 shall be grounds for judicial separation.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to provide that the grounds for divorce shall also be grounds for judicial separation.
