HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1146, L. D. 1595, Bill, "AN ACT Adopting Emission Regulations of the Department of Environmental Protection."

Amend said Bill in that part designated "§599." of section 8 by inserting at the end of paragraph A, before the semicolon, of subsection 3 the following 'or the quantity of material is such that it cannot be reasonably transported; and by striking out in the first line of paragraph B of subsection 3 (same in L. D.) the underlined word "suitable" and inserting in place thereof the underlined word 'reasonable'; and by striking out in the first line of paragraph D of subsection 3 (same in L. D.) the underlined figure "50" and inserting in place thereof the underlined figure '25'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment would allow for the burning of roadside brush when such brush would be in a quantity whereby it cannot be reasonably transported.
