COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 507, L.D. 1596, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Possession of Firearms by Persons Convicted of Criminal Offenses."

Amend said Bill in section 3 by striking out in the 7th and 8th lines of the 2nd paragraph of that part designated "§ 393." (6th line of L.D.) the underlined words and punctuation: "indecent liberties;"

Further amend said Bill in section 3 by striking out in the 9th and 10th lines of the 2nd paragraph of that part designated "§ 393." (8th line of L.D.) the underlined words and punctuation "rape; carnal knowledge;"

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to remove those convicted of rape, indecent liberties or carnal knowledge from the operation of the bill.
