HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1243, L. D. 1614, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Notification to Injured Employees of Rights under Workmen's Compensation Law."

Amend said Bill in the 7th line (5th and 6th lines in L.D.) by striking out the underlined punctuation and words ", either orally or"

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end before the Statement of Fact the following underlined paragraph:

'The State shall not be liable for any act or omission under this section.'

The purpose of this amendment is:

1. To delete the oral notification.
2. To relieve the State of any liability.
