**AN ACT Permitting Liquor Licensed Clubs to Sell Tickets to its Members
and Guests for Prizes to Raise Funds for Club Purposes.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T 28, § 305, amended. The last paragraph of section 305 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 372 of the public laws of 1969, is amended to read as follows:

Nothing in this section shall be construed to prohibit a licensed club from offering prizes, gratuities or other inducements, otherwise legal, as a means of promoting attendance on licensed premises **or raising funds for club purposes.** In offering such prizes, a licensed club may sell tickets to its members and guests.
