**AN ACT Appropriating Funds to Provide a Grant Writer for Bangor
State Hospital.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Bangor State Hospital; appropriation. There is appropriated to the Department of Mental Health and Corrections at Bangor State Hospital from the General Fund the sum of \$21,375 to provide a full-time grant writer at the Bangor State Hospital. This appropriation shall not lapse but shall remain in a continuous carrying account until the purposes of this Act have been accomplished. The breakdown shall be as follows:
