HOUSE AMENDMENT "A " to H. P. 1258, L. D. 1633, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to Benefits Payable under Workmen's Compensation
Law When Employer or Supervisory Employee Violates Safety
Statutes."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the first line
after the amending clause and inserting in place thereof the
following:

'§ 72. Violation of safety statutes and rules'

Further amend said Bill in the 6th line (5th line in L.D.)
by striking out the underlined words "negligence or"

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the end before
the Statement of Fact (same in L. D.) the following underlined
sentence:

' "Supervisory employee," as used in this section, shall have
the same meaning as "supervisor" as defined in and construed under
the Federal Labor-Management Relations Act, as amended.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to clarify the definition
of supervisory employees and to remove "negligence" from the
bill.
