HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to S. P. 515, L. D. 1639, Bill, "AN ACT
Establishing an Office of Early Childhood Development in Maine."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of section 2 and inserting
in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General
Fund the sum of \$25,500 for the period from January 1, 1974 to the
end of the fiscal year ending June 30, 1974, and \$51,000 for the
fiscal year ending June 30, 1975, to carry out the purposes of
this Act. The breakdown shall be as follows:
