COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1270, L.D. 1645, Bill, "AN ACT Prohibiting the Acceptance of Money for Enrollment of Voters."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of subsection 10 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'10. Money for enrollment. A person, firm or organization, who offers, solicits or accepts money or anything of value in return for enrollment of voters. This subsection shall not apply to paid executive employees of state committees who may organize enrollment programs for their respective parties.'

Statement of Fact

This Bill would prevent payment to persons for purposes of party enrollment. It would not prevent paid employees of state committees of political parties from conducting enrollment programs.
