CONFERENCE COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1270, L.D. 1645,
Bill, "AN ACT Prohibiting the Acceptance of Money for Enrollment
of Voters."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of subsection 10 and
inserting in place thereof the following:

'10. Money for enrollment. A person, firm or organization,
who offers, solicits or accepts money or anything of value in return
for enrollment of voters. This subsection shall not apply to
salaried employees of political committees. The payment of a
specific sum or bonus for a specific enrollment is prohibited in
all cases.'
