AN ACT Relating to Permits for Out-of-Door Fires Issued to Licensed Guides.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 1402, amended. Section 1402 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read as follows:

On application to the Forest Commissioner a yearly permit for out-of-door fires shall be issued to resident guides, licensed under section 2053, who collect a fee for their services. Such guides shall notify a forest ranger in person or by telephone the area in which they are guiding their parties. Whoever violates this paragraph shall have his permit revoked by the Forest Commissioner.
