Amend said Bill by adding at the end of the last line,
before the period and before the emergency clause, the following
' , such tolls to be reimbursed where Legislators use the Maine
Turnpike in traveling to and from sessions of the Legislature or
in performance of duly authorized committee assignments'

conditions a Legislator may apply for reimbursement of turnpike use.
