RESOLVE, Increasing Retirement Benefit of Charles S. Allen of Portland.

Charles S. Allen; retirement allowance adjustment. Resolved: That notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Maine State Retirement System is directed to provide an 11½% retirement allowance adjustment to Charles S. Allen of Portland. Such amount shall be computed by the Board of Trustees of the Retirement System.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Charles S. Allen, a teacher and administrator in the Portland School System, was forced to retire because of an unexpected health condition in June 1972. He had planned to retire in 1974 and had not given the required notice of intention in the fall of 1971, which was necessary for 1972 retirement with full benefits. He was thus deprived of the 11½% increase which went into effect in 1972. He hopes that this situation might be corrected.
