STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Provide that Consumers Shall be Included on Certain Boards.

Be is enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 5, § 43, additional. Title 5 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 43 to read as follows:

§ 43. Appointment of consumers to boards

Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Council, shall appoint 2 consumers to each of the following boards: Board of Chiropractic Examination and Registration; Board of Dental Examiners; Board of Examiners of Funeral Directors and Embalmers; Board of Commissioners of the Profession of Pharmacy; Board of Osteopathic Examination and Registration; State Board of Registration and Examination in Optometry; State Board of Nursing; Board of Registration in Medicine; Board of Examiners in Physical Therapy; State Board of Examiners for the Certification of Psychologists.

These appointees shall have the same rights and duties as other members of the boards to which they are appointed and shall be reimbursed in the manner provided for other members.
