SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 535, L.D. 1688, Bill, "AN ACT
Reestablishing the Capitol Planning Commission."

Amend said Bill by inserting before the enacting clause, the
following emergency preamble:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not
become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as
emergencies; and

Whereas, the purpose of the bill is to reestablish the
Capitol Planning Commission; and

Whereas, since there is contemplated construction in the
Capitol Area, it is essential that the commission be reestablished
as soon as possible to provide expert guidance for the orderly and
aesthetic development of the area; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts
create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of
Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary
for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now,
therefore, '

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the end, before the
Statement of Fact, the following emergency clause:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the
preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.'

The purpose of this amendment is to provide for an emergency
