## AN ACT Increasing Salaries of County Attorney and Assistant County Attorneys of Penobscot County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 30, § 2, amended. That part of the 11th paragraph of section 2 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, which relates to salaries of the county attorney and assistant county attorneys of Penobscot County, is further amended to read as follows:

county attorney, \$8,000 \$10,000; first assistant county attorney, \$6,000 \$7,500; second assistant county attorney, \$6,000 \$7,500;

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Attorney General the sum of \$8,750 to carry out the purposes of this Act. The breakdown shall be as follows:
