COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A" to S. P. 542, L.D. 1694, RESOLVE,  
to Develop a Comprehensive Development Concept for Maine Mountain  
Areas and Provide Funds for a Preliminary Plan.

Amend said Resolve in the 9th paragraph by striking out  
in the last line (same in L. D.) the word "and"

Further amend said Resolve by striking out all of the 10th  
paragraph (same in L. D.) and inserting in place thereof the following:

'3. To confer regularly with the Land Use Regulation Commission  
to assure that the committee work product will fulfill the purposes  
of this resolve; and

4. To submit such preliminary plan and all data and research  
material obtained by the committee to the Land Use Regulation  
Commission for its review and comment and, at the same time, to the  
Governor, the Joint Special Committee on Public Lands and appropriate  
officials of any organized governmental unit affected; and be it  
further

Resolved: That nothing contained herein shall be deemed to  
affect the jurisdiction or authority of the Land Use Regulation  
Commission over the unincorporated territories of the State; and be  
it further'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to clarify the relationship which  
must be established with the Land Use Regulation Commission to assure  
that a developmental plan will be created for the public's interest.
