STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

AN ACT Relating to Petition for Articles on Municipal
Ballots and Warrants.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 2061, sub-§ 4, amended. Subsection 4 of section 2061 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new paragraph at the end to read as follows:

If such particular article being placed on the next ballot printed or warrant of a special meeting requests raising, appropriating or borrowing of money by the municipality, it shall be accompanied by a recommendation of the municipal officers, or the school board where such action affects the school budget.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill requires that whenever an article is placed on the next ballot printed or warrant of a special meeting by the petition method stipulated in section 2061 and said article requires raising, appropriating or borrowing of money, it shall also be accompanied by a recommendation by the municipal officers or the school board.
