COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 1295, L.D. 1707, Bill,  
"AN ACT to Repeal the Minimum Age for Hospitalization of Mentally  
Ill Persons."

Amend said Bill in section 1 by inserting at the end the  
following new sentence: 'Any person 16 years of age or under  
must have the consent of his parent or guardian and the Commissioner  
of Mental Health and Corrections.'

Further amend said Bill in section 2 by inserting at the  
end the following new sentence: 'Any person 16 years of age or under  
must have the consent of his parent or guardian and the Commissioner  
of Mental Health and Corrections.'

Statement of Fact

The intent of this amendment is to permit persons 16 years of  
age or under to be admitted for hospitalization with consent of  
parent, guardian and Commissioner of Mental Health and Corrections.
